#### **No 1** Funny and exciting children stories

### No 4 Back in Time to the Land of Play



What were your parents' favourite toys and games. What did your grandparents like playing with best? What do you play with today? Where do toys come from? Do you learn anything from play? We'll be spending the morning at the Children's Museum in Baden. Our lively guide will encourage us to compare the toys of today with those of the past, and discover the unknown. In between there'll also be play breaks so we can discover different toys for ourselves.
